

The job of a Foster Carer, a Social Worker and a Judge.

Foster Carers are people who look after other people's children when Social Workers think they are not safe enough with their birth Mummy's and Daddy's. Children live with Foster Carers until they go to get adopted or go back to their birth parents.

A Social Workers makes sure that children are safe and not in any danger from living with their parents. They also have to make plans for the future for children with the help of the Judges in the Courts. The Social Workers job is also to try to help parents to look after the children better. If the parents cant do it in time for the child then Social Workers need to find adopters for them.

A Judge is a man or woman who works in a court and decides if the Social Workers have made the right decisions for the child. The Judge is the person who gives the Adoption Order to the new parents.
